- First Aid Kit

Medications – Tylenol, Kaopectate,
Benadryl, Sunscreen
- Glasses, Contacts & Solution
- Copies Of Important Documents –
Insurance, Wills, Birth Certificates,
Photo ID & Drivers License
- Tools – Wrench, Pliers, Multi-tool
- Waterproof Matches
- Mess Kit – Plates, Cups, Utensils
